

JUNIOR AND TEEN CAMP 2020
ORGANISATION – Conditions – Guide

1. Basic salary : (adapted for former counsellors, according to responsibilities and competences)

2. The camp pays Swiss social security taxes – a contribution of about 15 % of the gross salary (salary + full board + accident insurance)

3. Full board: Double room with private bathroom,
 meals in the restaurant with the campers,
 self-serve fruit, tea, and coffee,
 after work snacks during evening meetings

4. Laundry: Provided once a week

5. Days off: One afternoon and one evening per week
 July: + 1 full day
 August: + 1 full day

6. Insurance: Work-related accidents are covered by the camp insurance,
 Illness: you are required to purchase your own health
 insurance (verify that it is suitable for Switzerland),
 we require a copy of your insurance card together with the
 contract.

Description of work:

This is a camp, the campers are here 24 hours a day.

In the morning:

- wake up your 2-3 rooms and make sure that the campers have tidied their rooms, showered, and are dressed according to the weather and activities
- supervise and eat breakfast with the campers
- class: 2.5 hours of language courses, the classes have between 5 and 10 campers

In the afternoon:

- supervise and eat lunch with the campers
- lead or assist sport or artistic activities, site visits

In the evening:

- supervise and eat dinner with the campers
- lead or assist sport, cultural or artistic activities

Excursions: the counsellors are responsible for accompanying the campers on one day-long excursion per week, and sometimes one two-day excursion per session.

General rules:

Respect and discretion are fundamental and extend to the counsellor's presentation (i.e. clothing, hair) and the use of appropriate language. Cursing and vulgarity are strictly prohibited. Manifestations such as visible piercings and tattoos are not accepted. The camp is a meeting place for all and without prejudice therefore religious and political affirmations are not authorized.

The campers and counsellors come from more than 30 different countries making the experience for campers and counsellors extraordinary. However, this is a full-time job and you must be prepared both physically and mentally for this adventure!

For the former counsellors, as soon as we receive your confirmation we will send you the contract. If you are not interested in joining JTCamp this summer, we would appreciate that you let us know.
